Las Vegas Motor Speedway Track Rules (Friday and Saturday)

We are running on the bigger road course outside of the Las Vegas Motor Speedway. This is a rain or shine event. The format will be the same as the 2009 Shelby Vegas Bash.

This is NOT a race. This is Open Track for people to enjoy their cars in a NO PRESSURE, NON COMPETITIVE environment. Safety is our first priority, not how fast you can run someone down and stay on their bumper.

There are three classes to run your cars in:

Group I "Advanced" is for cars that have had the brakes, tires, and the seat belts modified. All open top vehicles must have a roll bar installed and have shoulder harness installed (arm restraints required in all open vehicles). Passing on the straights only is allowed. (NO CORNER PASSING).

Group II - "Intermediate". Safety is our first priority. Convertibles will be allowed in this class, Roll bars highly recommended. Passing will be allowed in designated areas.

Group III - "Novice" is a speed controlled group with three pace cars. The goal is for everyone to follow these cars and learn the correct line of the track. This is a slower pace for people to learn the lines, learn how your car handles, or have instructors in the car with you for hands on instruction. Convertibles are allowed in this class.

Shelby Vegas Bash Open Track Rules:

1. **Mandatory Driver's Meeting-** There will be limited number of driving instructors available to give you help along the way. A driver's meeting will be held early each morning at the base of the tower and you must attend each morning or you will NOT get on the track.
2. **Mandatory Tech Sheet and Driver Medical Forms-** You are ultimately responsible for making sure the car you are driving or riding in is safe. Please fill out and bring the Tech Sheet and Driver Medical documents with you. Check your tire thread thickness, tire pressures, brake pads and rotors, and meeting other rules below. Our inspectors will provide a courtesy safety check and answer any questions you have. Passing a courtesy tech is not a guarantee that the vehicle that you are driving or riding in is safe.
3. This Event is rain or shine. (No re-schedule dates.)
4. You must provide your own helmet to be in the car at the track. Type SA00 or SA05.
5. Long pants and long sleeve shirts must be worn.
6. You must attend the drivers meeting to get on the track.

7. Convertibles will be allowed in group II and group III, however top must be up.
8. You must keep your arms and hands inside the vehicle or close your windows.
9. Remove all loose items from the interior and trunk. (Example: No ice chests, extra helmets, or items that may shift around)
10. Turn off radios and air conditioning while in the track area.
11. Batteries must be tied down
12. Coolant overflow bottle must be in place
13. Race prepared vehicles only in group one (experienced class passing allowed)
14. Open top vehicles (example Cobra's) must have roll bar installed and must have shoulder harness and must have arm restraints.
15. If you have to be warned about you're driving more than once you will sit out the day to watch everyone else show you how it is suppose to be done.
16. **A track official's decision on any matter is final.**

Shelby Vegas Bash Poker Run (Saturday Morning)

First and foremost, everyone should thank Bud for providing such great detail and helping setup this Poker Run. This year's Poker Run is a very scenic route that takes us about 135 miles and should take approximately 3 hours to complete from start to finish. Make sure you give Bud your \$6.00 to get your dash plaque. Bud will use this money to pay the Ranger fee. If you don't have a dash plaque when you exit the park you will be required to pay \$6.00.



Police will be out and about as usual, so you are driving at your own risk. **SLOW DOWN** and obey all speed limits especially through Logandale and pay attention to the pictures below before lead footing through the Valley of Fire! **Speeding tickets in the Valley of Fire start at \$300.00.** The Valley of Fire is very scenic and there are lots opportunities to take fantastic pictures. As with most scenic drives there are some blind spots, tight turns and dips that all drivers must pay close attention to, so they don't get into trouble.

DISCLAIMER: This is a speed controlled drive with a lead car. To be VERY CLEAR, if you pass the lead car for any reason YOU will immediately LOSE your remaining time at the Vegas Bash with no refund and YOU will not be eligible to participate in any other future Team Shelby Events.

Start at the Aliante Casino Saturday Morning at 8:00 am. Please be there by 7:30 am to gather.



We will take **Hwy 215 East** to the **Hwy 15 North** ramp. Take **Hwy 15 North** to **Exit 93** (Logandale). This stretch is a total of 49 miles from the Aliante Casino to Logandale.

Watch Your SPEED

As you take **Exit 93** turn right (East) onto **Moapa Valley Blvd (Hwy 169 South)** and go about 6 ½ miles into town. Turn Left onto **Whipple Ave** and go about **1 mile** to the **Grant M.**

Bowler Elementary School (HUGE parking lot in front of building. This is the first stop—get first card. Come on Ace.....

Go back the way you came down **Whipple Ave** and make a **left turn** back onto **Moapa Valley Blvd (Hwy 169 South)**.



Watch Your SPEED

Continue about **7 miles** through town and on the back road to the **Valley of Fire Hwy**. Points of interest (if they are open) along this road include a Museum and Wildlife

Sanctuary in town.



Turn **right** onto **Valley of the Fire Hwy** into the Valley of Fire State Park and go to the Visitor's Center lower parking lot for the second stop. I want a King!

After leaving the second stop, **turn right** onto the main road.

You will go about 3 1/5 miles and **turn right**. This will lead you close to the **Visitor's Center**. Right before the entrance to the Visitor's Center, **bare left** and follow the sign to the **Mouse's Tank/White Dome**.

Follow the road until it **dead ends** at the **White Domes**. This is **about 6 1/2 mile** trip to the 3rd stop of the run. Where are you Queen?



Watch Your SPEED Now the road is ASWEOME!!!!!! Please Pay Attention because there are some dips, twists and turns. It is a one of a kind PAVED road and simply beautiful!!!!!! After getting your card, take the road back down and go to the main road. Make a right and go **about 2 1/2 miles** and **make a right turn at the sign for Atlatl Rock**.



Atlatl Rock is the 4th stop of the run. I feel a Jack in my future! You can park and walk up to the stairs to check out the Petroglyphs on the side of the cliff, if so desired.



After leaving the 4th stop, come back to the main road and make a right turn to the Ranger's Station. It is about 2 miles from the last stop. Here you may be required to pay the \$6.00 fee to the park. Please be prepared.

Watch Your SPEED After leaving the station, you will go about 16 miles and get onto **Hwy 15 South**. Continue on **Hwy 15 South** for **about 23 miles** and take **Hwy 215 West**. Continue on **Hwy 215 West** for about **4 1/2 miles** and get off at the **Losee exit**. **Turn left at light** onto **Losee**. Continue on **Losee** about **1/2 mile** to **Deer Springs Road**. Continue **Deer Springs** about **1 mile** to the Stop Sign. **Turn right** onto **5th Ave** and go to the light. **Turn right** onto **Dorell** and a quick right into the **In-Out Burger** and there you will receive the final card!
